

### **300.10 Mailbox Damage Policy**

Mailbox claims will be settled by payment of \$30.00 to replace those boxes damaged by a snow plow or other town vehicle directly hitting them, if a resident alerts the Town office within ten days of the occurrence. The town at the claimant's option may install a replacement US Postal approved mailbox of the town's choosing. This does not cover snow/slush thrown by the plow that knocks a mailbox over, if the mailbox post is not structurally sound. Those not following this policy may make a claim as provided on Wis. Stat. 345.05(2).
