

102.1 Five Member Town Board Ordinance

SECTION I – AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Berry has specific authority, powers and duties, pursuant to Sec. 60.10, 60.20, 60.21, 60.22 and 60.23, (1993-1994) Wis. Stats., and has, with authorization of the Annual Town Meeting, additional statutory authority, powers and duties under Sec. 61 (1993-1994) Wis. Stats., to manage and direct certain affairs of the Town of Berry.

SECTION II – PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to create a five (5) member Town Board for the Town of Berry.

SECTION III – NUMBER OF TOWN BOARD MEMBERS

Pursuant to Sec. 60.21 (1), (1993-1994) Wis. Stats., The Town Board of the Town of Berry shall be increased to five members commencing with the election and qualification of two (2) additional supervisors in the 1996 spring election and thereafter the Town Board of the Town of Berry shall consist of five (5) members.

SECTION IV – ELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Pursuant to Sec. 60.21 (1), (1993-1994) Wis. Stats., the Town of Berry shall elect three (3) supervisors in odd-numbered years and two (2) in even-numbered years.

SECTION V – QUORUM OF THE TOWN BOARD

A legal quorum of the Town Board of the Town of Berry that consists of five (5) members shall require three (3) members for a legal quorum when they are in attendance at any duly called or duly authorized public meeting.

SECTION VI – EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage by the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Berry and one day after the proper publication and posting required by Wisconsin Statutes. The Clerk should schedule the election of Town additional supervisors in the 1996 spring election.
