

102.2 Appointed Clerk/Treasurer Position Ordinance

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SECTION I – PURPOSE

It is deemed expedient, necessary and in the best interests of the Town of Berry, Dane County, Wisconsin and the public to adopt an ordinance that provides for the appointment of the combined office of town clerk and town treasurer.

SECTION II – GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A. Enact an ordinance that provides for the appointment of a person by a majority of the members-elect of the town board, as defined in Sec. 59.001 (2m) to fill the combined office of town clerk and town treasurer.
- B. This ordinance may not take effect until it is approved in a referendum called by the town board for that purpose at the spring election on April 7, 1998 to be held no sooner than 45 days after the referendum is called by the Town Board.
- C. The referendum question shall be: “Shall the person holding the combined office of town clerk and town treasurer in the Town of Berry be appointed by the Town Board?”
- D. If the ordinance is approved in a referendum, the change from an elective to an appointive office may not take effect until the term of office of the incumbent town clerk and town treasurer expires.
- E. Additional provision applying to this ordinance may be found in Sec. 60.30 (1e) WI Stats.

SECTION III – EFFECTIVE

This ordinance shall take effect after approval by referendum at the spring election on April 7, 1998 and proper publication and posting required by law.
