

400.1 To Adopt the Comprehensive Plan Ordinance

The Town Board of the Town of Berry, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Pursuant to section 62.23(2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Berry is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The Town Board of the Town of Berry, Wisconsin, has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes

The Plan Commission of the Town of Berry, by a majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted Resolution 2002-7 recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the document entitled "TOWN OF BERRY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN," amended to address input received at the Public Hearing and comments from the Dane County Planning and Development Department and the Dane County Regional Planning Commission, and containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The Town of Berry has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The Town Board of the Town of Berry, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "TOWN OF BERRY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN," pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board and publication/posting as required by law.
