

### **400.3 An Ordinance To Adopt the Amended Town of Berry Comprehensive Plan**

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 60.22(1) and 60.23(33) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town is authorized to prepare and amend a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Berry has previously approved the comprehensive plan known as Town of Berry Comprehensive Plan, adopted November 18, 2002, updated July 19, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board adopted a public participation plan to encourage public participation in the formation and review of the comprehensive plan amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission, by a majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted Resolution 2012-4 recommending that the Town Board adopt an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan, incorporate the amendment into the existing Comprehensive Plan, adopted November 18, 2002, updated July 19, 2010 and readopt the amended Comprehensive Plan as the “Town of Berry Comprehensive Plan”; and

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2012 the Town of Berry Town Board held a public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Berry, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the amended document entitled, “Town of Berry Comprehensive Plan,” pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board and publication/posting as required by law.
