  - Motion do burn ourselves with various volunteers Molling/Hook. Motion passed 2-0.

  - Motion assemble list of suitable plants, solicit donation from residents, Berry Backyard Club, etc. Molling/Hook. Motion passed 2-0.
8. Discussion/action re: Possible shrubs/trees/vines around fuel tank.
  - Motion recommend to Board to use cedar fencing to hide tank. Maybe plants next to one or two sides afterwards Molling/Hook. Motion passed 2-0.

  - Motion try to get high school students and/or UW Hort students to do plant inventory, and guide timing of seed collection this year Molling/Hook. Motion passed 2-0.

  - General consensus that high school students are welcome, but attracting their involvement is a challenge.
