

**TOWN OF BERRY**

**RESOLUTION 2021-1**

**TITLE: Establishing an American Rescue Plan Act Grant Account**

WHEREAS, the Federal Government made \$1.9 trillion dollars available to states, counties, municipalities, tribes and territories, including \$130 billion for local governments split evenly between municipalities and counties, through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) which was signed into law on March 11, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Berry's share of the ARPA funds is estimated to be \$124,241.57; and

WHEREAS, the ARPA funds will be distributed to the Town in two equal payments, with the first payment to be distributed on June 25, 2021, and the second payment to be distributed approximately 12 months later; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by federal and state agencies that the ARPA funds be held in a separate revenue budget line account in the General Fund to insure accurate accounting, monitoring and reporting of ARPA funds.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Berry, establishes a revenue budget line account with a description of "ARPA Local Recovery Funds" and directs the Clerk to set up said revenue fund in the accounting software and follow the Wisconsin Department of Revenue account structure for governmental funds.
